Gift Aid Declaration

Your donation is eligible for Gift Aid. This allows the Science Museum, with your consent, to claim basic-rate tax relief, increasing the value of your donation at no additional cost to you. If you are a higher-rate taxpayer, you can claim higher-rate tax relief on your donation in your Self Assessment tax return.

I am eligible as a UK taxpayer and consent to the Science Museum claiming Gift Aid on all donations. I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 that I gave up to 5 April 2008 and will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give on or after 6 April 2008.

The Direct Debit Guarantee

Tear/cut off and keep your Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, the Science Museum will notify you within 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by the Science Museum or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your Bank or Building Society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the Science Museum asks you to. You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify the Science Museum.
