

# SCIENCE NIGHT



## Group leader information

We're really excited about meeting you and your group on Science Night. We've put this leaflet together so you know what to expect on the night. There is also a 'camper survival guide' for each of the children you are bringing.

### Adult responsibilities:

- Ensuring your group follows the Science Night rules set out in the health and safety talk on the night.
- Ensuring your group doesn't disturb those who are sleeping.
- Disciplining your group.

### How do we get to the Science Museum?

#### By car

Imperial College car park (next door),  
18.00–12.00, charge £10

#### By tube

South Kensington Underground Station  
– District, Circle and Piccadilly lines

### What should we bring?

- Sleeping bag
- Toothbrush
- Packed evening snack
- Water bottle

### You might also want:

- A pillow
- Eye shades for sleeping (some lighting is left on overnight)
- A mobile phone
- Pyjamas

### Please do not bring:

- Radios
- Torches
- Camp beds or inflatable beds
- Alcohol

### Where and when do we arrive?

Science Museum Main Entrance at 18.45

### What if we arrive late?

Go to the Science Museum Group Entrance on Imperial College Road.

### When do we leave?

Science Night finishes at 10.00 the next day. The Science Museum will open to the public at this time and you are welcome to stay and explore some more!

### Where will we sleep?

- You will be sleeping on the floor amongst our objects! We will provide you with a thin sleeping mat.
- Boys and girls have separate sleeping areas, although you will sleep in the same gallery.
- Children will need supervision while sleeping. Female adults can sleep on either side of the gallery; male adults can only sleep on the boys' side.

### When and what will we eat?

- We recommend you eat an evening meal before coming to Science Night.
- You'll eat your packed snack at around 20.40.
- No food and drink will be on sale during Science Night.
- Breakfast will be provided. It usually consists of a croissant, fruit, cereal bar and fruit drink.

### Emergencies

- We have a first-aider on duty throughout the whole event.
