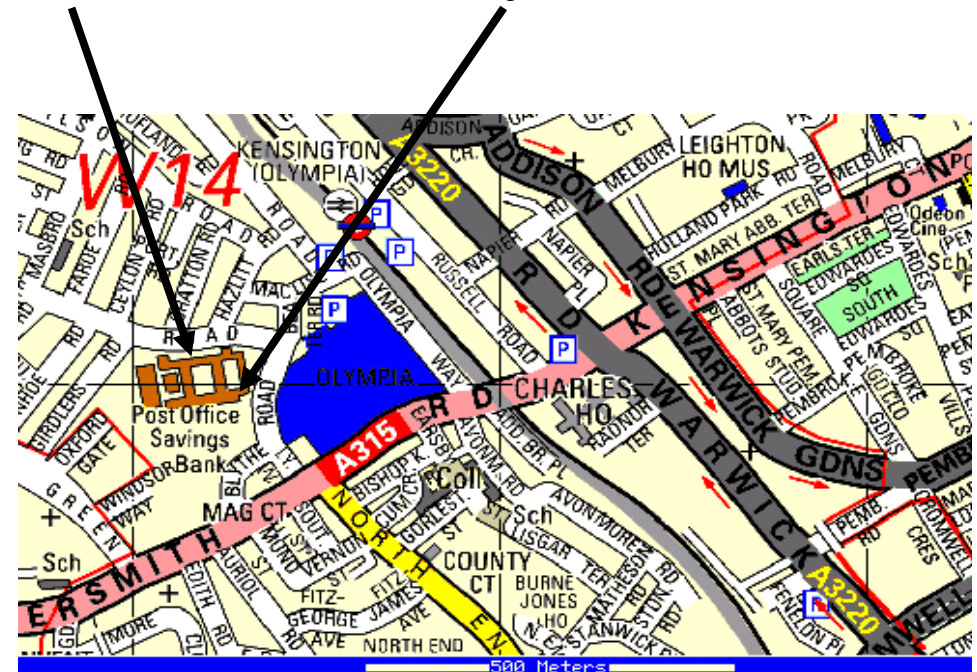

Overground & South Central Trains both run services to Kensington (Olympia) via Willesden Junction & Clapham Junction. Trains to & from Clapham Junction stop at West Brompton station to interchange with the District line.
