- Bowls
- Mixing utensils
- Pipette
- 500 g sodium bicarbonate powder
- 250 g citric acid monohydrate
- Scales

- Scoops
- Paper cake cases
- Spray bottle
- Witch hazel
- Food colouring
- Food flavouring or fragrance oils
- Latex-free gloves

Using the pipette add a few drops of fragrance, and again mix it in very quickly.

Working quickly and evenly, spray the witch hazel over the dry mixture a couple of times. The mixture should still feel dry.

Mix thoroughly. You should be able to mould the fizzer mixture by pressing it firmly

together.

You can either press the mixture into a paper cake case or use a spatula to mould it into a shape. Leave it to dry for a few hours.

Put your fizzer into water and watch it fizz!
