We're looking forward to seeing you, but before you get here please read this sheet and make sure your parents or guardians read it too – it tells you more about what will happen on the night.

What do I bring?

- Sleeping bag
- Toothbrush
- Packed evening snack
- Water bottle

You may want to bring some money for the shop. Ask your group leaders to keep it safe until you need it.

Please do not bring:

- Electronic items such as mobiles phones or tablets
- Torches

It is your responsibility to look after everything you bring with you, including during the night while you are asleep. If you lose or damage something, the museum can't be held responsible.

What will I eat?

Please remember to bring your packed evening snack to Astronights as you cannot buy food on the night.

There will be water fountains throughout the museum for you to fill up your water bottles.

We'll give you breakfast, which is usually a croissant, fruit muffin and juice.

What will I be doing?

Astronights is an overnight science extravaganza. We have lots of fun activities, shows and workshops planned for you.

To have the best time possible there are a few things you need to remember:

- Listen to the staff – they are the museum experts
- Always stay with your group leader – we don't want you to get lost
- Think about the other campers in your group and try not to disturb others

Where will I sleep?

You'll sleep among our objects on the floor of one of our amazing galleries. To help you feel a bit more comfortable we'll provide you with a thin camping mat.

We'll make sure that you are sleeping with the rest of your group, but there will be other groups and staff in the gallery with you, so please try to be as quiet as possible if others are trying to sleep.

What time does Astronights start and finish?

Astronights starts at 18.45 and finishes at 10.00 the following day.

If you are being picked up on the day after Astronights, your parent or guardian should meet you at the Information desk when the museum opens at 10.00.
